Thank you for the information you provided below in response to SAHA's PAIA request regarding the identification and treatment of intersex children.

I would appreciate if you would further clarify for me the following matters:

1. You indicated that no written policies or standard operating procedures exist at the hospital regarding intersex patients. Am I correct in understanding that to mean that there is no standard or fixed definition of intersex applied by the hospital?

Yes that is true

2. Are you the only doctor (with support from the multidisciplinary team you identified) at the hospital that makes decisions regarding the identification of children as intersex?

Yes

3. You indicated that lectures to registrars and students happen from time to time but not according to a structured curriculum. Can you please provide the details of any lectures provided to registrars and students regarding intersex issues in the last 3 years? In particular the dates and content of the lectures. If copies of power point presentations given or papers presented at those lectures are available I request that copies are please provided
