PAIA Request - Archdiocese of Cape Town 2011/0087/CDC

In response to your request for information dated 21 October 2011 to Archbishop Brislin about records held by the Archdiocese of Cape Town, I can confirm the following:

- 1. The Archdiocese of Cape Town has no records related to consultation, policies or practices aimed at eliminating [or promoting] unfair discrimination, including harassment, against lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex employees.
- 2. A grievance procedure is available to employees of the Archdiocese of Cape Town who feel they may have been discriminated against. The procedure is laid down in the Staff Handbook of the Archdiocese.
- 3. No complaint relating to allegations of unfair discrimination on the basis of gender, sex or sexual orientation has been made by any employee or prospective employee of the Archdiocese of Cape Town in the last five years.
