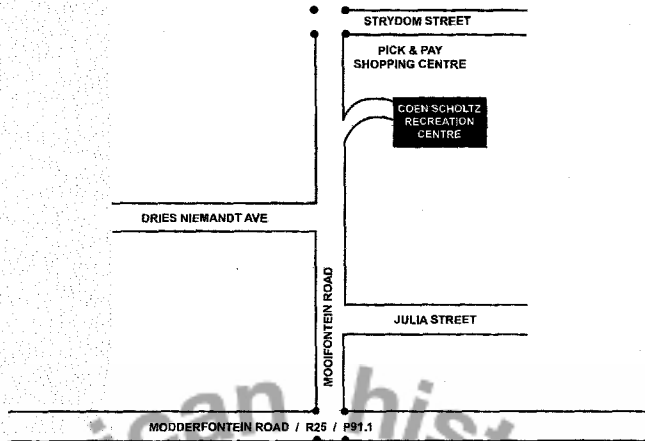

Rules of Entry:

1. Works of art may be entered during 21 - 23 August 2012 between 09:00 - 19:00 at the Coen Scholtz Recreation Centre, Mooifontein Road, Birchleigh North, Kempton Park.

Satellite Entry Points:

Springs Art Gallery, c/o 5th & 6th Avenue between the library and the community hall, on 21 - 22 August 2012 between 09:00 - 19:00.

Katlehong Art Centre, 203 Sontonga Street, Phooko Section, on 23 August 2012 between 09:00 - 16:00

Boksburg Library Auditorium, Trichardt Street, Boksburg Civic Centre, on 24 August 2012 between 09:00 to 16:00

Art works entered at the Springs Art Gallery, Katlehong Art Centre and Barry de Villiers Art Gallery can only be art works on paper and canvas.

All sculptures and installations must be entered at the Coen Scholtz Recreation Centre.

Entry forms will be provided at the venues on the above mentioned days. An entry fee of **R50.00** per art work is payable upon entering the competition.

2. All art works must be ready and suitable for exhibition. The works of art must have been completed in the 12 months prior to the competition.

3. Adjudicating will take place on 28 - 30 August 2012. Only the adjudicators will be allowed during the adjudication process. The adjudicators determine the right to set the standards of the competition.

The adjudicators for 2012 are:

Khwezi Gule, Gwen Miller, Siphon Mdanda, Angeline Le Roux and John Mfuphi????

4. All unselected works must be collected on 3 - 7 September 2012 between 08:00 and 16:00 at the Coen Scholtz Recreation Centre, Mooifontein Road, Birchleigh North, Kempton Park.

Organisers will not be responsible for unselected works of art that are not collected on the specified dates. Artists whose works are not selected for the exhibition will be notified telephonically.

5. The prize winners will be announced on 22 September 2012 at the opening of the exhibition at 18:00 at the Coen Scholtz Recreation Centre. Prize winners will be notified telephonically that they must attend the opening function.

6. One hundred art works will be selected by the adjudicators for an exhibition. The artists of these art works will be notified that they must attend the opening function.

7. The exhibition may be viewed by the public free of charge from 25 September? - 16 October 2012? daily from 10:00 - 17:00.

8. Art works that were selected for the exhibition and art works sold on the opening night may only be collected from 08:00 to 16:00 on 16 - 19 October 2012?? at the Coen Scholtz Recreation Centre. The organisers accept no responsibility for works of art not collected on these days.

9. The total prize money is R 70 000.00

The following prizes will be awarded:

First Prize	R 30 000.00
Ekurhuleni Prize	R 20 000.00
Multi & New Media Merit Award	R 5 000.00
Painting Merit Award	R 5 000.00
Art on Paper Merit Award	R 5 000.00
Sculpture Merit Award	R 5 000.00

10. Art works entered for the competition must be for sale and may not belong to anybody else. The purchase price of each art work must be indicated on the entry form.

11. Any artist with a valid South African I.D. Book may participate in the competition and any number of art works may be entered. There is no limit on size, but the dimensions of the facility must be taken into account.

12. The decision of the adjudicators is final and no correspondence or verbal enquiries may be addressed to the organisers in this regard.

13. The first prize winner will be required to serve on the adjudicators' panel for the next fine arts award.

14. There are no age categories and all mediums are allowed. Art works are judged on their merit.
