RE: POLICY ON PUBLIC GATHERINGS OUTSIDE THE GATHERINGS ACT

The above mentioned request for a record which was received by our office on the  $8^{th}$  of September 2015 has reference. Notwithstanding the fact that we did not receive payment you are required to make for copies of pages made as provided for in the Fee Gazette, the municipality hereby provides the record and hope that the necessary payment will be made in due course. The amount payable is R0.60 x 68 pages = R40.80). It took the municipality less than an hour to search for the record and as a result thereof, no payment is required for time services.

The Emfuleni Local Municipality does receive applications for gatherings, marches, picketing, petition presentations and et cetera and in line with the provisions of section 17 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, the municipality complies with the provisions of the Regulations of the Gatherings Act, Act 205 of 1993. Furthermore it must be noted that the Municipality does not have a policy on the subject matter but has established a forum known as Joint Operations Committee which comprises of South African Police Services, Municipal Officials from various departments such as the Traffic and Security Division (which is the custodian of the function), legal department and other relevant departments which might have a role in the actual application.

The function of JOC is to look into each and every application and check various things such as the route chosen for the march that is, are they major public routes or not. If they are major routes check will the march, for example cause traffic jams., the safety of the public and security to be given by the applicants on safety issues, to mention a few. This



is done in terms of section 3 of the Regulations. The JOC will then make recommendations to a higher body consisting of SAPS, Crime Intelligence, Public Order Police Services and Traffic and Security Department of the Municipality. This committee will in turn meet in terms of section 4 of the Regulations to finalise the terms and conditions of the application. Normally the applicants are invited to attend.
