TRANSFER OF REQUEST FOR RECORDS IN TERMS OF SECTION 20(1) OF PROMOTION OF ACCESS TO INFORMATION ACT, 2000 (PAIA)

Your request for access to records detailing the skills development training delivered to the Rysmierbult community 881Q refers. The request refers to an attached letter of 14 May 2008 which letter was not attached.

Your request for access to records was received by the Director-General on 26 September 2011. In accordance with paragraph 1, Part A of your request –

- (i) no documents related to the project can be found on any file or system in the possession of the Department of Higher Education and Training; and
