## **DEPROCLAMATION OF PART OF THE K69 ROUTE**

The City of Tshwane recently established a Mayoral Special Task Team (MSTT) to deal with the formalization and proclamation of old townships within the City's jurisdiction area. Part of the mandate requires relocation of informal settlements to formalized and serviced stands.

The K69 route is situated within the boundary of the proposed Mahube Valley Extension 15 area where the existing informal settlement is to be upgraded in-situ. However note that the extent of the informal settlement far outweighs the number of proposed stands.

The MSTT is of the opinion that the part of the K69 as depicted in the attached map may never be built due to excessive slopes and associated costs on the north-eastern side of the proposed township. Furthermore a need exists to maximize available developable land in the vicinity.

From the above, the MSTT therefore kindly request that part of the K69 route as depicted on the map be de-proclaimed in order to reduce the road width, and to re-align this route internal to the prosed Mahube Valley Extension 15 if required.
