- 3.1.2 in any way disrupting the normal activities of the Applicant, including registration, classes, lectures, tutorials and the like;
- 3.1.3 obstructing or preventing any person from entering or leaving the precinct of the Applicant or any of its buildings, facilities, residences, halls, classrooms and the like;
- 3.1.4 in any way causing damage to the property of the Applicant, its staff or students;
- 3.1.5 participating in, calling for, inciting or encouraging unlawful behaviour;
- 3.1.6 harassing, intimidating, threatening or assaulting any of the Applicant's students or staff or service providers, or members of the public in any manner whatsoever;
- 3.1.7 carrying firearms or dangerous weapons defined in the Dangerous Weapons Act 15 of 2013, or knives or sticks of any kind on the Applicant's precinct
- 3.2 the South African Police Service and/or Public Order Policing Unit are directed to assist the Applicant in enforcing this order and to take steps or measures that are necessary to ensure compliance with this order and to maintain law and order at the Applicant's premises.
- 4. Service of this Court order is to be effected in the same manner as the application was served, which is set out below:-
 - 4.1 emailing a copy of the order directly to the First to Sixth Respondents;
 - 4.2 affixing copies of this order to various notice boards at the main entrances to the Applicant's precincts.
- 5. No order as to costs.
