- Please note the following issues when analysing the table provide in 3: 2
 - 2.1 The Criminal Law (Sexual Offences and Related matters) Amendment Act 2007 was implemented on the 16th of December 2007. Before the Act was amended the legal definition of rape included female victims only.
 - 2.2 During the investigations of crime, crime categories may change as a result of further information uncovered by the detectives.
 - 2.3 The South African Police Services uses the Crime Administration System (CAS) to administer crime data. CAS is a live and changing system. This means that if one draws figures for the same crime category for the same period (e.g. month, quarter, etc.) and space (i.e.station, province and national) but at different times, the results will be different.
