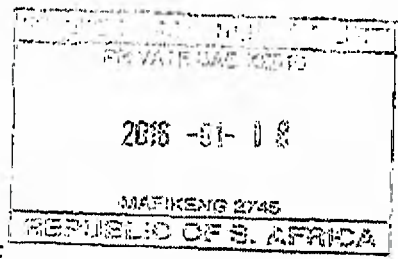

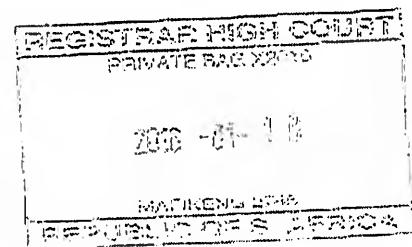
1. THAT: the application be considered on an urgent basis in
 terms of the provisions of Rule 6 (12) of the Rules of
 this Honourable Court.

2. THAT: The Respondents and all other students of the
 Applicant University (herein after referred to as "the
 University") represented by the Respondents be and
 are hereby interdicted with immediate effect from:

2.1 Arranging, organising, instigating or participating in any
 manner whatsoever any violent demonstrations, actions or
 protests on the Mafikeng Campus of the Applicant
 University;

- 2.2 Preventing in any manner whatsoever, undisturbed entrance and access to the said campus to all members of the Management of the University, of the Staff and independent contractors and service providers to the University;
- 2.3 interfering in whatever manner with the managerial functions of the management of the University;
- 2.4 interfering in any manner whatsoever with the rights of co-students and any other people to study, to participate in the writing of examinations, student orientation and/or to register or re-register as students at the Applicant University;
3. THAT: The order set out in paragraph 2 above be an interim order with immediate effect and that a rule nisi be and is hereby issued calling on the Respondents to show cause on Thursday, 18th February at 10:00 why:
4. the said interim orders should not be made final.
5. THAT: This order be made known:
- 5.1 By affixing a copy thereof in a prominent place to or nearby the main gate to the University;

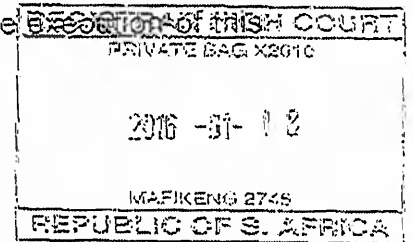

5.2 By e-mailing a copy thereof to all Registered Students of the University by any person or persons acting on the instructions or authority of the Campus Rector; and

5.3 By placing a copy thereof on the face book page of the University.

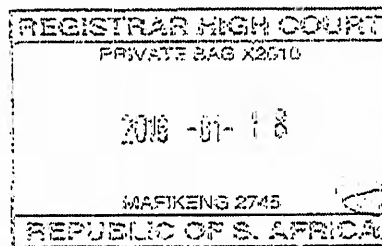
6. THAT: The Sheriff of this Court be and is hereby authorised to request or enlist the services and assistance of the South African Police Services in so far as it might be necessary for the proper and effective execution of this order; and



7. THAT: The South African Police services (SAPS) are authorised to assist the Sheriff of this court in so far as it might be necessary for the proper and effective execution and implementation of this order, and in particular that the SAPS are authorised to enter the campus of the University and to stay on campus for as long as it might in their view be necessary to so assist the Sheriff
