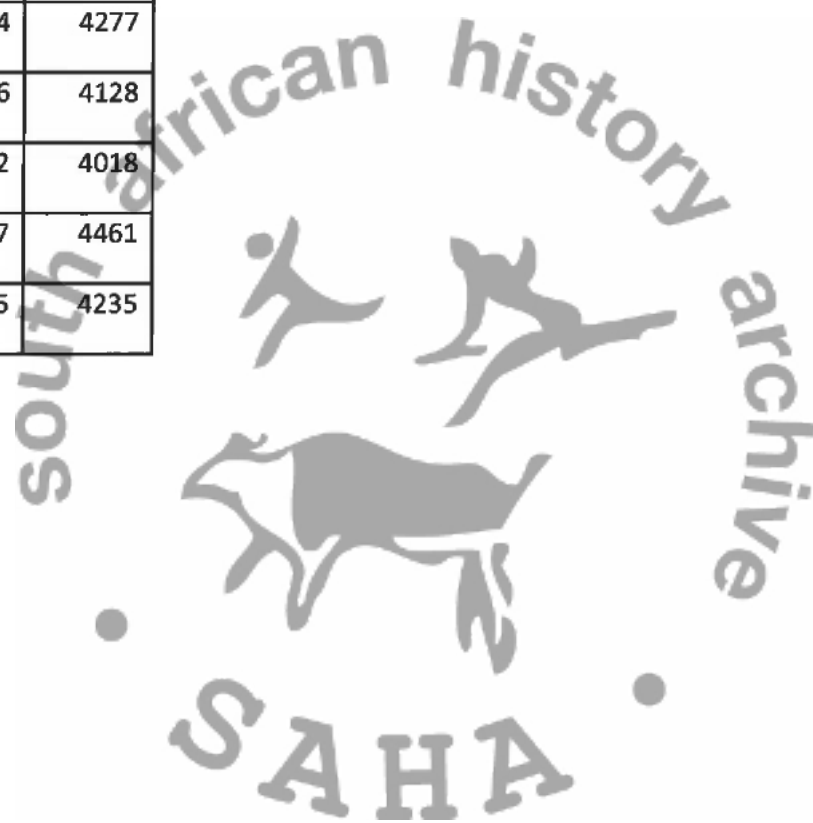

- 2) Number of inmates who died as a consequence of violence by officials (assault official on inmate) for period 2009/2010 to 2012/2013.
