BY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARTIES THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS  
MADE:

1. The Respondents hereby undertake that they will not :

1.1 Participate in unlawful protest action on the campus of the University of the Western Cape ('UWC');

1.2 Call for, or incite unlawful protest action on the campus of UWC which includes students or other persons disrupting lectures, disrupting tests or exams, attempting to enter university buildings for the purposes of either of the above activities, and preventing students or university staff from carrying out their lawful activities;

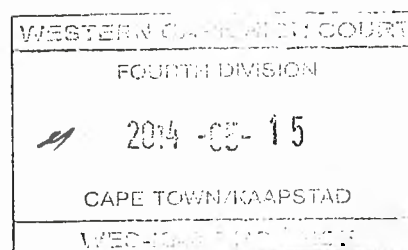
1.3 Disrupt lectures, tests or examinations;

1.4 Enter into or attempt to enter university buildings for the purposes of either of the above activities, and preventing students or university staff from carrying out their lawful activities;

1.5 Damaging University property, or calling upon anyone else to do so; and

1.6 Obstruct and/or disrupt vehicular traffic entering the campus or on the campus.

2. The Applicant hereby undertakes not to institute disciplinary action against the First to Twelfth Respondents as a result of the protest action that took place between 6 and 11 March 2014.



3. The First to Twelfth Respondents undertake to cooperate with an independent investigator appointed by the university's senior management to investigate the underlying causes of the protest action.
4. The Order is made final in respect of the Thirteenth Respondent.
5. There is no Order as to costs.
