**UPON** reading the Notice of Motion, and the other documents filed of record; and

UPON the motion of Counsel for the Applicant;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1.

That a rule *nisi* do hereby issue calling upon the Respondents to show cause on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of **SEPTEMBER 2015** at 09h30 or so soon thereafter as counsel may be heard as to why an order should not be granted in the following terms:

1.1 That the first to seventh respondents, in relation to the applicant's premises located at Westville Campus, Howard College, Durban, Edgewood Campus, Pinetown, Nelson R Mandela School of Medicine, Durban and Pietermaritzburg Campus, Pietermaritzburg, be and are hereby interdicted and restrained from:

- 1.1.1 assaulting, intimidating, harming or harassing in any way, any person;
- 1.1.2 damaging or removing any of the applicant's property;
- 1.1.3 barricading, restricting or in any way interfering with the entrances or access points to any of the applicant's premises;
- 1.1.4 preventing, restricting or in any way interfering with the access to and ingress from any of the applicant's premises by any person or vehicle;
- 1.1.5 organising, instigating or co-ordinating any unlawful gathering, demonstration or mass action on any of the applicant's premises;
- 1.1.6 participating in any unlawful gathering, demonstration or mass action on the applicant's premises;

1.2 That the first to seventh respondents be and are hereby directed, in relation to any grievances, demands, intended marches, gatherings, protests, rallies or demonstrations to follow the applicant's prescribed regulations and procedures governing such events.

1.3 That the eighth respondent be and is hereby directed to assist members of the applicant's security and risk management staff to ensure that the aforesaid interdict is implemented on the applicant's premises.

1.4 That any respondent opposing the application be directed to pay the costs of the application jointly on an attorney and client scale.

2.

That the relief set out in paragraph 1.1 to 1.3 above operate as interim relief with immediate effect pending the outcome of the application.

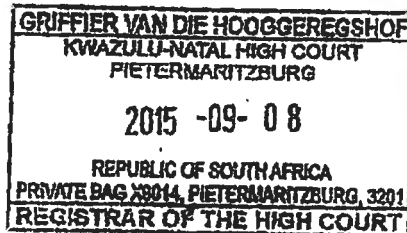
