- Oral history allows you to compensate for the digital age.
- Oral history allows you to learn different kinds of information.

- Oral history provides historical actors with an opportunity to tell their own stories in their own words.
- Oral history provides a rich opportunity for human interaction. History, after all, is all about the human experience.
- Through oral history, researchers and interviewees come together in conversation about a commonly shared interest —as with all human interactions, this has the potential to be tremendously rewarding for both parties.
