

Back in the late seventies while the rest of the music world was being rejuvenated by the punk explosion, South Africa was sadly lacking in musical excitement. And then from that small East Rand town called Springs came the **Radio Rats**, with an album called "Into the Night We Slide", an album that the music press declared was ten years ahead of it's time, and an album that contained one of South Africa's great pop tunes "ZX Dan", and a whole bunch of other greats that were a little too sleazy for the powers at the S.A.B.C. of the time. **The Rats** revealed a depth of songwriting talent and lyrical ability that the industry had presupposed only existed "overseas" - and inspired by **The Rats**, a whole bunch of other bands sprung out of the garage and into the public domain -Corporal Punishment, The Asylum Kids, National Wake etc. etc.....

Now there's a new album out - it's called **Big Beat**. The Rats are back with a whole new batch of songs that are even better - songs like "East Rand Town Called Springs", about a nightmarish bus drive down the main road courtesy of a bald, toothless bus driver and a ghoulish conductor, songs like "Love is a Virus":

"When the pebbles of the gravedigger bop upon your coffin lid, and the eyes of the priest say 'I told you so, I forgive you for what you did'"

and the title track, "Big Beat":

"I go downtown, where I hang around, Where the Big Beat brings the girls and boys I dress so strange, it's like a sex change I don't want to, but I have to, I have no choice...."

So here it is - an album that will remind old Rats fans why they liked the band so much in the first place, and capture a whole new audience for the best rock band in the country. And remember the next 12 songs are written already. And the next 12. And the next.
