Dear Senator Rheinallt Jones,

Referring further to your letter of the 11th ultimo in the above connection, I have made enquiries into the matter and have ascertained that this Department has supported the Village Council's proposal to raise a sub-economic loan of £30,000 as a charge against the Native Revenue Account for the purpose of carrying out a native housing scheme in the location.

In your letter you mention that you called at my Pretoria office several times in this connection, but could not get any definite information.

On this point I can only say that no one in either the Urban Areas or Lands Sections has any recollection of the said interviews.
